

Featherston Art Sale Guidelines: 10 – 13 May 2018



Eligible work: Artwork can be in any medium or format. Artwork can be suitable for display either indoors or outdoors. Artwork must be ready to be installed - art meant to be hung on the wall must be ready to be hung and outdoor art must be weatherproof and wind resistant. Work must be by a Wairarapa artist or an artist associated with the Wairarapa. We will not accept pieces that we have shown previously.

Fees: A minimum 30% commission from each sale will go to the Featherston Community Centre Community Trust. We are happy to accept a larger commission.

Selection criteria: Please use our online registration. If you have a Google or Gmail account please register at <https://goo.gl/forms/9k4ykjHY6aVXRO6k2>. Otherwise please register at <https://tinyurl.com/yd4ynmfl> or contact us for other arrangements. **DEADLINE to register is 5pm, Saturday 21 APRIL.** While we would like to accept all work, please understand that we have limited display space. Preference will be given to Artists or Artwork associated with Featherston or the Featherston Booktown event. If we accept more than one piece, only one may be displayed until more space becomes available through the cash and carry sale.

Publicity: Artwork may be photographed and the artwork and images used for promotional purposes.

Delivery: All selected artwork is to be delivered with attached information on Artist, Title, Medium and Price to the Featherston Community Centre, 14 Wakefield Street on Monday 7 May, or by arrangement.

Insurance: Insurance for artwork while in transit between and while on display is the artist's responsibility. All reasonable care will be taken with the works but the Featherston Community Centre cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage during the display or while in transit.

After the Sale: All artwork must be picked up at the close of sale - 3:00 -5:00pm Sunday. If your artwork has sold, your proceeds will be deposited in your bank account within 7 days. The Featherston Community Centre does not have storage facilities and will charge a \$10/day storage fee without prior arrangements. Artwork stored beyond 3 months will become the property of Featherston Community Centre.

Please note: Any artwork not delivered on time, not accompanied by the required details, not ready to be hung or displayed, or that does not conform to the above requirements will not be entered into the sale.
